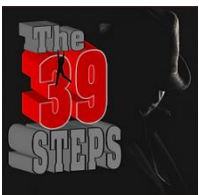

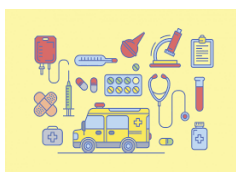
Prince George's County Animal Services Facility and Adoption Center (ASFAC):

Effective Thursday, August 17, the Prince George's County Animal Services Facility and Adoption Center (ASFAC) will temporarily close to the public due to an outbreak of canine influenza to quarantine, treat, and care for the affected animals. The canine influenza virus is one of the viral causes of kennel cough. It does not affect humans but is highly contagious for dogs and can be fatal.
